### Draping Fabric Using Liquid Polymer Clay

Bookings are now being taken for this masterclass with Philippa Todd - to be held in Lichfield, Staffordshire on Sunday 12th September 2010.

Philippa is an International Tutor and has now been awarded Fellowship status with the International Guild of Miniature Artisans. We are delighted to invite her back to the Midlands Region.

During the class we will make a quilted duvet/eiderdown that will then be positioned on a bed to show a made, unmade or occupied bed.

You will also make a simple pillow to fit the bed.



You will also back a tablecloth with polymer clay and put permanent realistic folds into the material.

If time allows you will make some tea towels to add realism to your miniature kitchens.

Using this technique to drape curtains and valances will also be discussed.
